Prewash with STAIN PREP™ - MILL GLAZE AWAY® to make your paints and stains last longer. Maximize coating performance by removing dirt, mildew, waxy residue and mill glaze. Prepare your wood so paints and stains penetrate fully and evenly. STAIN PREP™ is specifically made to condition wood to the proper pH prior to applying new generation waterborne wood finishes.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Dissolve contents into 9 L • 2.5 gal. of warm water (above 27°C • 81°F). Apply with mop, sponge, brush, roller or garden sprayer. Wait 5-15 minutes and agitate with brush and rinse with water. Allow wood to be dry-to-touch before applying new coating.

COVERAGE:

Up to 500 sq. ft - 46 sq. m. (per bag depending on surface).

PRECAUTIONS:

Wear rubber gloves and eye protection. Avoid ingestion or contact with skin or eyes. Wear personal protective equipment. When spraying wear NIOSH/MSHA approved respirator. Do not expose to bare metal.

FIRST AID:

WHAT IS MILL GLAZE?

"Mill glaze" is a term used by the coatings industry to define the smooth glossy-like surface that develops on newly milled lumber. This glossy surface or "mill glaze" is caused by planers and saw blades turning at extremely high speeds. The high temperature and pressure can literally polish the wood to a glaze-like condition. It is these shiny looking or mill glazed areas that prevent proper coating penetration and adhesion resulting in premature peeling and failure.

WHY USE STAIN PREP™?

Use of STAIN PREP - MILL GLAZE AWAY® will allow for immediate coating application with **Natural Deck Oil™** without the need to allow wood to season. Standard practice has been to allow new-wood to weather unprotected for up to 90 days. This weathering process solves the problem of mill glaze through exposure of wood to sun and water. However, outdoor exposure to sunlight (ultraviolet radiation) and water can cause wood to discolor.

CONTRACTORS HINTS:

STAIN PREPTM helps protects against wood rot, mold and mildew with a natural borate wood treatment. Protect new wood decks, fences, siding and other structures when you build them so they retain their natural look. Prewash with STAIN PREPTM and immediately coat with Natural Deck OilTM before graying and weathering begin. Use STAIN PREPTM on pressure (CCA) treated lumber to condition the surface before painting or staining. If wood surface appears gray and weathered, use WOODWASHTM. If wood needs heavy duty cleaning use Simple WashTM then STAIN PREPTM.
